



NDIS CARE SUPPORTS:

- Comprehensive Physical Health Assessments ie. continence assessments
- Personalised care plans to address specific needs or challenges
- Personal care
- Private Nursing in your home
- Carer education – either face to face or via zoom. Can be used by NDIS participants to train and educate support workers
- Medication administration & management
- Respite and Community support/engagement
- Support for clients at regular GP or specialist appointments
- We can accompany clients to special events where care can be provided throughout the day/evening
- Indwelling catheter care, syringe driver support, other nursing procedures that may not be able to be attended to after hours
- Wound care and treatment (cleaning & dressing, monitoring for signs of infection or complications and implementing appropriate intervention to promote healing)
- advocacy and coordination of care
- pressure area care and prevention
